Tone 5 *(for the Resurrection)*

By Your <u>pre</u>cious <u>Cross</u>, O Christ, You have put the <u>dev</u>il to shame. By Your Resur<u>rec</u>tion, You have blunted the <u>sting</u> of sin and <u>saved</u> us from the <u>gates</u> of death.// We glorify You, O <u>on</u>ly begotten One.

V. (6) If You, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You.

<u>Christ</u> was led as a sheep to the <u>slaughter</u> in order to grant Resurrection to the <u>human race</u>. The <u>princes</u> of hell were <u>fright</u>ened by this, for the <u>gates</u> of sorrow were <u>lift</u>ed. Christ the King of glory had <u>entered</u>, <u>saying to those in <u>chains</u>: "Go forth!"// And to those in <u>darkness</u>: "Come to the light!"</u>

V. (5) For Your Name's sake I wait for You, O Lord. My soul has waited for Your word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

O great wonder!

The Creator of the invisible suffered in the flesh in His <u>love</u> for man and <u>rose</u> again immortal.

Come, O sons of nations,

let us worship Him,

for delivered from error by His compassion,//

we have learned to sing of one God in three Persons!

V. (4) From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord!

(Resurrection stichera by Anatolius)

We <u>of</u>fer You our evening <u>wor</u>ship,

O never setting Light,

Who came in these last days to the world in the flesh;

Who even descended to hell to dispel its darkness.

Who has revealed the light of Resurrection to the <u>na</u>tions.//

Glory to You, O Lord and Giver of light!

V. (3) For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver Israel from all his iniquities.

Tone 6 (for the Fathers) (Despairing for her life)

You were begotten from the Father before the <u>Morning Star</u>, but Arius taught wrongfully that You were created: in his ignorance he designated You as a <u>crea</u>ture, yet the Fathers of the Council proclaimed You as <u>Son</u> of God,//co-enthroned with the Father and the Holy <u>Spirit</u>.

V. (2) Praise the Lord, all nations! Praise Him, all peoples!

O honored Fathers,

you skillfully stitched together the <u>gar</u>ment of Christ, which had been divided and torn apart by <u>barking</u> dogs. You found it unbearable to see His <u>na</u>kedness, as of old Shem and Japheth could not bear to see the nakedness of their <u>fa</u>ther. You put to shame the wretchedness of Arius and those who agreed with him,// and who professed the madness that <u>bears</u> his name.

V. (1) For His mercy is confirmed on us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever.

The Macedónians and Nestórians, the Eutýchians and Di<u>ós</u>corenes, the Appolinárians, Sabéllians, and <u>Sév</u>erans, who were revealed as oppressive wolves in <u>sheep's</u> skins, you, as true shepherds, drove far away from the <u>Sav</u>ior's flock, having stripped the thrice-wretched ones of their <u>sheep's</u> skins.// Therefore, we call you blessed, O holy <u>Fa</u>thers.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit;

Tone 6 *(for the Fathers)*

Today let us praise the mystical trumpets of the <u>Spirit</u>, the God-bearing <u>Fa</u>thers, who stand in the midst of the Church, singing true the<u>ology</u>, praising the changeless <u>Trin</u>ity!

They laid low the errors of <u>Arius</u> and upheld the <u>Orthodox Faith.//</u>

They always entreat the Lord to have <u>mer</u>cy on our souls.

now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Tone 5 (*Theotokion – Dogmatikon*)

In the Red Sea of old, a type of the Virgin Bride was prefigured. There Moses divided the waters; here Gabriel assisted in the miracle. There Israel crossed the sea without getting wet, here the Virgin gave birth to Christ without seed. After Israel's passage, the sea remained impassable; after Emmanuel's birth, the Virgin remained a Virgin. O ever-existing God Who appeared as Man,// O Lord, have mercy on us!

Tone 5 *(for the Resurrection)*

We <u>magnify</u> You in <u>songs</u> of praise, O incarnate Christ and <u>Sav</u>ior. By ac<u>cepting</u> the Cross and <u>death</u> for our sake, as the <u>Lord</u> and <u>Lover</u> of man, You overthrew the <u>gates</u> of hell,// and arose on the <u>third</u> day, <u>sav</u>ing our souls.

V. The Lord is King; He is robed in majesty!

By being <u>pierced</u> in the side, O <u>Lover</u> of man, You have poured out drops of life and sal<u>vation</u> for all. By ac<u>cepting</u> death in the flesh, You have granted us immor<u>tal</u>ity. You have <u>freed</u> us by being <u>placed</u> in the tomb, and have resurrected us with Yourself in <u>glory</u>, as God.// Glory to You, O Lord and Lover of man!

V. For He has established the world, so that it shall never be moved.

Your cruci<u>fix</u>ion and descent into hell are awesome, O <u>Lov</u>er of man. You have captured it, releasing the ancient <u>pris</u>oners. You have <u>opened Paradise</u> and <u>giv</u>en it to us. <u>Grant</u> us purification of sins, who glorify Your Resurrection on the <u>third</u> day! Make us <u>wor</u>thy of <u>Paradise</u>// and save us, O Lover of man!

V. Holiness befits Your house, O Lord, forevermore!

For our <u>sake</u>, You accepted <u>death</u> in the flesh, to rise from the dead on the <u>third</u> day. <u>Heal</u> us from our earthly <u>passions</u>, and restore us from our evil transgressions;// and <u>save</u> us, O <u>Lover of man!</u>

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit;

Tone 4 *(for the Fathers)*

Come, all Orthodox <u>Churches</u>, let us celebrate today in faith and true <u>worship</u> the <u>yearly</u> commemoration of the divinely-arrayed <u>Fa</u>thers who gathered at Nicea from through<u>out</u> the world! There they refuted the godless <u>teaching</u> of <u>Arius</u>, banishing him from the catholic Church by a decree of the <u>council</u>. They taught all to confess openly the <u>Son</u> of God, consubstantial and co-eternal with the <u>Fa</u>ther, proclaiming this with precision and true worship in the <u>Sym</u>bol of Faith. Therefore, as we faithfully follow their divine <u>doc</u>trines, let us worship the Father, the Son, and the most <u>Ho</u>ly <u>Spir</u>it,// the consubstantial Trinity in one <u>God</u>head!

Tone 4 (Theotokion)

Look on the entreaties of your servants, O <u>Blame</u>less One! Stop all the terrible attacks against us, <u>free</u>ing us from every af<u>flic</u>tion, for we have only you as our sure and firm <u>an</u>chor! Do not let us be put to <u>shame</u>, O <u>Lady</u>, for we call on you for our inter<u>ces</u>sion! Hasten to pray for those who <u>call</u> in faith: "Rejoice, O <u>Lady</u>, <u>Help</u> of all:// the Joy and Shelter and Sal<u>va</u>tion of our souls!"

(at Great Vespers)

Tone 5 Troparion (*Resurrection*)

Tone 8 Resurrectional Dismissal Theotokion

For our sake You were <u>born</u> of <u>the Virgin</u> and endured cruci<u>fix</u>ion, O <u>Good</u> One, destroying <u>death</u> by death.

Revealing the <u>Resurrection</u> as God, do not despise the <u>work</u> of Your hand!

Reveal Your <u>love</u> for <u>man</u>, O Merciful One, and accept the Theotokos <u>pray</u>ing for us,//

and save the despairing <u>people</u>, O our <u>Sav</u>ior!

(at the Divine Liturgy)

Tone 5 Troparion (Resurrection)

You have delivered Adam from the curse, O <u>Lov</u>er of man,// and we cry to You: "O <u>Lord</u>, <u>save</u> us!"

Tone 8 Kontakion (*Fathers*)

The Apostles' <u>preaching</u> and the <u>Fa</u>thers' doctrines have established one <u>Faith</u> for the Church.

Adorned with the <u>robe</u> of truth, <u>wo</u>ven from heavenly the<u>ol</u>ogy,// It defines and <u>glo</u>rifies the great <u>mys</u>tery of <u>pi</u>ety.

Tone 5 Prokeimenon (Resurrection)

You, O Lord, shall protect us / and preserve us from this generation forever. (*Ps.* 11:7)

V. Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer any that is godly! (Ps. 11:1a)

Tone 4 Prokeimenon (Song of the Three Holy Children)

Blessed are You, O Lord God of our fathers, / and praised and glorified is Your Name forever! (Song of the Three Holy Children, v. 3)
