15<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost, Sunday After the Exaltation of the Cross Martyr Sophia, and her three daughters: Faith, Hope, and Love

#### "Lord I Call..." Tone 6

Lord, I call upon You, <u>hear</u> me! <u>Hear</u> me, O Lord! Lord, I call upon You, <u>hear</u> me! Receive the <u>voice</u> of my prayer, when I <u>call</u> upon You!// Hear me, O Lord!

Let my <u>prayer</u> arise in Your sight as <u>incense</u>, and let the lifting <u>up</u> of my hands be an evening <u>sacrifice!//</u> Hear me, O Lord!

**V.** (10) Bring my soul out of prison, that I may give thanks to Your Name!

## **Tone 6** (for the Resurrection)

Possessing victory over <u>hell</u>, O Christ, since You are <u>free</u> among the dead, You as<u>cended</u> the Cross raising with Yourself those who sat in the <u>shades</u> of death.// Drawing life from Your light, O almighty Savior, have <u>mer</u>cy on us!

V. (9) The righteous will surround me, for You will deal bountifully with me.

Today Christ <u>tram</u>ples on death, for He is <u>ris</u>en as He said!
Let us all <u>sing</u> this song, for He has granted <u>joy</u> to the world:
O Light unapproachable, O <u>Foun</u>tain of life!//O Savior almighty, have <u>mer</u>cy on us!

V. (8) Out of the depths I cry to You, O Lord. Lord, hear my voice!

Where shall we sinners flee from You, Who are in all creation? In <a href="heaven">heaven</a> You dwell! In hell You <a href="mailto:trampled">trampled</a> on death! In the <a href="mailto:depths">depths</a> of the sea? Even there is Your hand, O <a href="mailto:Master!">Master!</a> To You we flee, and falling be<a href="mailto:fore">fore</a> You, we pray://
O You Who rose from the dead, have mercy on us!

V. (7) Let Your ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications!

(Resurrection stichera by Anatolius)

In Your Cross, we <u>glo</u>ry, O Christ. We sing and glorify Your Resur<u>rec</u>tion. For <u>You</u> are our God,// and we know no <u>oth</u>er than You.

**V.** (6) If You, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You.

**Tone 1** (for the Cross) (Joy of the Heavenly Hosts)

The <u>Cross</u> is exalted; the demons are <u>driv</u>en away.

The <u>thief</u> opens the gates of <u>Paradise</u>; death is slain and openly despised, as <u>Christ</u> is <u>magnified</u>.

<u>Therefore</u>, rejoice, all those <u>born</u> on earth,// for the curse has been lifted!

**V.** (5) For Your Name's sake I wait for You, O Lord. My soul has waited for Your word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

<u>Come</u>, all <u>lov</u>ers of God, beholding the Exaltation of the <u>pre</u>cious Cross, let us <u>magnify</u> it together, giving glory to the one Deliverer and <u>God</u> as we <u>cry</u> out: "You were <u>cru</u>cified on the <u>wood</u> of the Cross.// Do not turn from us who <u>pray</u> to You!"

V. (4) From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord!

In days of <u>old</u>, Moses changed bitterness into <u>sweet</u>ness. He delivered Israel, prophetically inscribing the <u>image</u> of the Cross. As <u>we</u>, the faithful, ever make the sign of the Cross <u>mys</u>tically in our hearts,//we are <u>saved</u> by its might.

**V.** (3) For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver Israel from all his iniquities.

**Tone 4** (*for the martyrs*) (*You have given a sign*)

The virgin maidens, bound to one another by the law of <u>na</u>ture, manifestly made stronger by love of the Cre<u>a</u>tor, <u>loosed</u> the bonds of de<u>cep</u>tion with faith.

They valiantly trampled the <u>Enemy</u> and were radiantly adorned with fair <u>crowns</u> of <u>vic</u>tory.//

Now they rejoice, dwelling in the heavenly bridal <u>cham</u>ber.

V. (2) Praise the Lord, all nations! Praise Him, all peoples!

The all-praised Faith and <u>glo</u>rious Love together with divinely <u>wise</u> Hope, re<u>vealed</u> themselves to be namesakes of the most splendid <u>vir</u>tues. As athletes, they overthrew the <u>E</u>vil One who had deceived our First <u>Moth</u>er with guile. Now they are deified and dwell in <u>Par</u>adise// where they fervently <u>pray</u> for us all.

V. (1) For His mercy is confirmed on us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever.

Faith, Hope and Love, the daughters of So<u>phi</u>a, sought with faith the beauty of the <u>Bridegroom</u>. They u<u>nit</u>ed themselves to Him, adorning themselves with di<u>vine</u> wounds; they despised the fire, manifold tortures and a <u>shame</u>ful death.// Through their prayers, O Lord, deliver us from <u>e</u>vils!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit;

#### **Tone 1** (for the Cross, by Andrew of Jerusalem)

The <u>Tree</u> of True Life was planted in the <u>Place</u> of the Skull and upon it You, the eternal King, have worked salvation in the <u>midst</u> of the earth.

Exalted today, it sanctifies the <u>ends</u> of the world, and the church of the Resurrection celebrates its <u>de</u>di<u>ca</u>tion. <u>Ang</u>els in <u>heav</u>en rejoice, and men upon <u>earth</u> make glad, crying a<u>loud</u> with David and <u>say</u>ing: "Exalt the Lord our God and <u>wor</u>ship at His <u>foot</u>stool,// for He is holy, granting the world great <u>mer</u>cy!"

Your Resurrection, O Christ our <u>Sav</u>ior, the Angels in <u>heaven sing!</u> Enable <u>us</u> on earth// to glorify You in <u>pur</u>ity of heart!

V. The Lord is King; He is robed in majesty!

Destroying the <u>gates</u> of hell, breaking the <u>chains</u> of death, You resurrected the fallen human race as al<u>mighty</u> God!// O Lord, Who rose from the dead, <u>glory</u> to You!

**V**. For He has established the world, so that it shall never be moved.

Desiring to return us to <u>Paradise</u>,
