#### "Lord I Call..." Tone 8

Lord, I call upon You, hear me! Hear me, O Lord!
Lord, I call upon You, hear me!
Receive the voice of my prayer, when I call upon You!//
Hear me, O Lord!

Let my <u>prayer</u> arise in Your sight as <u>incense</u>, and let the lifting <u>up</u> of <u>my</u> hands be an evening <u>sac</u>rifice!// Hear me, O Lord!

V. (10) Bring my soul out of prison, that I may give thanks to Your Name!

## **Tone 8** *(for the Resurrection)*

We <u>offer</u> to <u>You</u>, O Christ, our evening song and reasonable <u>ser</u>vice, for You <u>willed</u> to have <u>mer</u>cy on us// by Your Resurrection.

**V**. (9) The righteous will surround me; for You will deal bountifully with me.

Lord, <u>Lord</u>, do not cast us a<u>way</u> from Your face! For You willed to have <u>mer</u>cy on us// by Your Resur<u>rec</u>tion.

V. (8) Out of the depths I cry to You, O Lord. Lord, hear my voice!

Rejoice, O holy Zion: Mother of the churches, the a<u>bode</u> of God, for you were the first to re<u>ceive</u> re<u>mis</u>sion of sins// by the Resurrection.

V. (7) Let Your ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications!

## (Resurrection stichera by Anatolius)

The <u>Word</u> of God the <u>Fa</u>ther, begotten before the <u>ages</u>, in the latter times willed to be in<u>car</u>nate of the <u>Virgin</u> and endured cruci<u>fi</u>xion unto death. He has <u>saved</u> mortal man// by His Resurrection.

**V.** (6) If You, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You.

We glorify You, O Lord, for You voluntarily endured the <u>Cross</u> for our sake. We fall down in worship before You, O al<u>mighty Sav</u>ior. Do not cast us a<u>way</u> from Your face but hear us and save us, O <u>Lov</u>er of man,// by Your Resur<u>rec</u>tion!

**V.** (5) For Your Name's sake I wait for You, O Lord. My soul has waited for Your word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

<u>Glo</u>ry to You, O <u>Sav</u>ior Christ, Only-begotten Son of God, who was <u>nailed</u> to the Cross// and resurrected from the tomb on the <u>third</u> day!

**V.** (4) From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord!

**Tone 6**\* (from the Lenten Triodion) (Having placed all their hope)

The Lord took a handful of <u>dust</u> from the earth. He breathed into it and created me, a <u>liv</u>ing man. He made me lord and master of <u>all</u> things on earth; truly I enjoyed the life of the <u>angels</u>. But Satan the deceiver tempted me in the guise of a <u>ser</u>pent; I ate the forbidden fruit and forfeited the <u>glo</u>ry of God. Now I have been delivered to the <u>earth</u> through death.// O my compassionate Lord, call me back to <u>Ed</u>en!

**V.** (3) For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver Israel from all his iniquities.

When the Enemy <u>tempted</u> me, I disobeyed Your com<u>mand</u>, O Lord. I exchanged the glory of my mortal body for shame and <u>na</u>kedness. Now I must wear garments of skins and <u>fig</u>-leaves; I am condemned to eat the bread of bitter hardship by the <u>sweat</u> of my brow. The earth is cursed and brings forth thorns and <u>husks</u> for me. O Lord, You took on flesh from the Virgin in the <u>full</u>ness of time;//call me back and restore me to <u>E</u>den!

V. (2) Praise the Lord, all nations! Praise Him, all peoples!

O Paradise, garden of delight and <u>beauty</u>, dwelling-place made <u>perfect</u> by God, unending gladness and e<u>ternal</u> joy, the hope of the prophets and the <u>home</u> of the saints, by the music of your rustling leaves beseech the Creator of all to open the gates which my <u>sins</u> have closed, that I may partake of the Tree of <u>Life</u> and Grace// which was given to me in the beg<u>inning!</u>

**V**. (1) For His mercy is confirmed on us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever.

Adam was exiled from Paradise through disobedience; he was driven from eternal bliss, deceived by the words of Eve; he sat naked and weeping before the gates of Paradise. Let us hasten to enter the season of fasting; let us carefully obey the Gospel commands, that we may be made acceptable to Christ our God,// and regain our home in Eden!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit;

# **Tone 6** *(from the Lenten Triodion)*

Adam sat before the gates of <u>Ed</u>en, bewailing his nakedness and <u>cry</u>ing out: "Woe to me! I have listened to <u>wicked</u> deceit; I have lost my glory, and now am <u>driv</u>en away! Woe to me! My open-mindedness hath left me <u>naked</u> and confused! No longer will I enjoy your delights, O <u>Paradise</u>; no longer can I see my Lord, my God and Creator. He formed me from dust, and now to the <u>dust</u> I return! I beg You, O compassionate Lord://

now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

# **Tone 8** (*Theotokion – Dogmatikon*)

The <u>King</u> of heaven, because of His <u>love</u> for man, appeared on earth and <u>dwelt</u> with men. He took <u>flesh</u> from the pure <u>Virgin</u> and after assuming it, He came <u>forth</u> from her. The Son is one: in two natures, yet one <u>Person</u>. Proclaiming Him as perfect <u>God</u> and <u>perfect Man</u>, we confess <u>Christ</u> our God!//
Entreat Him, O unwedded Mother, to have mercy on our souls.

## **Aposticha**

## **Tone 8** *(for the Resurrection)*

Descending from heaven to ascend the Cross, the eternal Life has <u>come</u> for death to raise <u>those</u> who are <u>fal</u>len; to enlighten those in <u>darkness.//</u> O Jesus, our Savior and illuminator, <u>glory</u> to You!

**V**. The Lord is King; He is robed in majesty!

We <u>glor</u>ify Christ, who <u>rose</u> from the dead. He accepted the human <u>body</u> and soul, and freed <u>both</u> from <u>suf</u>fering. His most pure soul descended to <u>hell</u>, which He spoiled. His holy body did not see cor<u>rup</u>tion in the tomb.// He is the Redeemer of our souls.

**V**. For He has established the world, so that it shall never be moved.

In <u>psalms</u> and songs we glorify Your Resurrection from the <u>dead</u>, O Christ. By it, You have freed us from the <u>tor</u>tures of hell// and as God have granted eternal life and great <u>mercy</u>.

**V**. Holiness befits Your house, O Lord, forevermore!

O<u>Mas</u>ter of all, incomprehensible Creator of <u>heav</u>en and earth, by Your suffering on the Cross You have gained <u>pas</u>sionlessness for me. Accepting burial and a<u>rising</u> in glory, You resurrected Adam with Yourself by Your al<u>mighty</u> hand. Glory to Your rising on the <u>third</u> day! By it You have granted us eternal <u>life</u> and <u>cleansing</u> of sins// as the only com<u>pas</u>sionate One.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit;

#### **Tone 6** *(from the Lenten Triodion)*

Adam ate the forbidden fruit and was driven from <u>Par</u>adise. He sat outside, weeping <u>bit</u>terly:

"Woe to me! What will become of me, a <u>worth</u>less man? I disobeyed one command of my Master and lost <u>eve</u>ry good thing! O holy Paradise, planted for me by God, and closed by the <u>weak</u>ness of Eve, grant that I may once again gaze on the flowers of your <u>gar</u>dens!" The Savior <u>said</u> to him:

"I do not wish the death of My creation!

I desire that all should be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth,//

for him who comes to Me I shall <u>nev</u>er cast out!"

## Tone 6 (Theotokion)

My Maker and Redeemer, <u>Christ</u> the Lord, was born of you, O most pure <u>Virgin</u>. By accepting my nature, He freed Adam from his <u>an</u>cient curse. Unceasingly we magnify you as the <u>Moth</u>er of God! Rejoice, O ce<u>les</u>tial Joy! Rejoice, O <u>La</u>dy://
the Protection, Intercession and Sal<u>va</u>tion of our souls!

## **Tone 8** Troparion (Resurrection)

You descended <u>from</u> on <u>high</u>, O <u>Mer</u>ciful One! You accepted the <u>three</u> day <u>bur</u>ial to free us from our <u>suf</u>ferings!// O Lord, our Life and Resurrection, glory to You!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

#### **Tone 8** Resurrectional Dismissal Theotokion

For our sake You were <u>born</u> of <u>the Virgin</u> and endured cruci<u>fix</u>ion, O <u>Good</u> One, destroying <u>death</u> by death.

Revealing the <u>Resurrection</u> as God, do not despise the <u>work</u> of Your hand!

Reveal Your <u>love</u> for <u>man</u>, O Merciful One, and accept the Theotokos <u>pray</u>ing for us,//

and save the despairing people, O our Savior!
